If you have let your house to another, please provide website and pool information to your tenants. Tenants should also provide their names to the lifeguards to avoid misunderstandings at the pool.

As in the past, please note:

The Centers for Disease Control and the State of Ohio have issued guidelines for pool disinfection in connection with recreational water-borne illnesses. An "accident" can mean pool closure for a *minimum* of 24 hours! In fact, it is highly likely that the pool will be closed for two to three days, depending upon the type of accident and pool temperatures. If you or your child is ill, *please* do not use the pool until you are symptom-free for at least 24 hours.
